



## Influenza Vaccinations

This year there will be 3 different influenza vaccines, dependent upon age.

For people aged 65 years and over, you will be able to receive the FLUAD® QUAD Vaccine. It cannot be given to people under the age of 65 years.

People aged Under 65 years will receive the AFLURIA® QUAD vaccine.

Children aged 6 – 35 months will receive the AFLURIA® QUAD JUNIOR vaccine.

Vaccines will be available for people aged 65 years and over from the 14 April, 2021.

For those people within high risk groups, vaccines will be available from 21 April, 2021.

For the general population vaccines will be available from 28 April, 2021.

We cannot give vaccines earlier than the dates specified above.

Administration of the vaccines is dependent upon the practice receiving the vaccines that have been ordered. Please be patient if your appointment has to be cancelled due to non-supply of the vaccine.

**IMPORTANT** – If you are having the covid vaccination, you must wait 2 weeks until after the second dose of the covid vaccine has been given before you have the influenza vaccine.

If you have had the influenza vaccines, you must wait 2 weeks before starting the covid vaccination schedule.

You cannot have an influenza vaccine at the same time as the covid vaccinations.
